#### Use network providers and pharmacies

UHC MedicareMax Complete Care FL-30 (HMO C-SNP) has a network of doctors, hospitals, pharmacies and other providers. This health plan requires you to select a primary care provider (PCP) from the network. Your PCP can handle most routine health care needs and will be responsible to coordinate your care. If you need to see a network specialist or other network provider, you may need to get a referral from your PCP. We encourage you to find out which specialists and hospitals your PCP would recommend for you and would refer you to for care, prior to selecting them as your plan's PCP. If you use providers or pharmacies that are not in our network, the plan may not pay for those services or drugs, or you may pay more than you pay at a network pharmacy.

You can go to **PCNhealth.com** to search for a network provider or pharmacy using the online directories. You can also view the plan Drug List (Formulary) to see what drugs are covered and if there are any restrictions.

UHC MedicareMax Complete Care FL-30 (HMO C-SNP) is insured through UnitedHealthcare Insurance Company or one of its affiliated companies, a Medicare Advantage organization with a Medicare contract. Enrollment in the plan depends on the plan's contract renewal with Medicare.
